## AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 5, 1947 (P.L.1217, No.498), entitled 2 "An act to promote the education and educational facilities of the people of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; creating a 3 State Public School Building Authority as a body corporate 4 5 and politic with power to construct, improve and operate 6 projects and to lease the same and to fix and collect fees, 7 rentals and charges for the use thereof; authorizing school 8 districts to enter into contracts to lease; authorizing and 9 regulating the issuance of bonds by said Authority; and providing for the payment of such bonds and the rights of the 10 holders thereof; granting the right of eminent domain; increasing the powers and duties of the Department of Public 11 12 13 Instruction; and providing that no debt of the Commonwealth 14 shall be incurred in the exercise of any of the powers granted under this act; and making an appropriation to said 15 Authority to pay expenses incident to its formation, "further 16 17 providing for award of contracts.
- 18 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows: 19
- 20 Section 1. The first paragraph of section 10, act of July 5,
- 21 1947 (P.L.1217, No.498), known as the "State Public School
- Building Authority Act, amended April 20, 1949 (P.L.636, 22
- 23 No.142), is amended to read:
- 24 Section 10. Competition in Award of Contracts. -- If any
- 25 project or any portion thereof, or any improvement thereof,

- 1 shall be constructed pursuant to a contract, and the estimated
- 2 cost thereof exceeds [five hundred dollars (\$500),] two thousand
- 3 (\$2,000), such contract shall be awarded to the lowest
- 4 responsible bidder after advertisement for bids once a week for
- 5 three weeks in at least one newspaper of general circulation in
- 6 the county where the project or improvement is located. The
- 7 Authority may make rules and regulations for the submission of
- 8 bids and the construction or improvement of any project or
- 9 portion thereof. No contract shall be entered into for
- 10 construction or improvement of any project or portion thereof,
- 11 or for the purchase of materials, unless the contractor shall
- 12 give an undertaking with a sufficient surety or sureties
- 13 approved by the Authority, and in an amount fixed by the
- 14 Authority, for the faithful performance of the contract, and
- 15 such contract shall be accompanied by an additional bond for the
- 16 protection of those who furnish labor and material, for such
- 17 amount and subject to the same terms and conditions as
- 18 recommended by The Administrative Code of one thousand nine
- 19 hundred twenty-nine, as amended, on contracts entered into by
- 20 the Department of Property and Supplies for the erection of
- 21 buildings. All construction contracts shall provide, among other
- 22 things, that the person or corporation entering into such
- 23 contract with the Authority will pay for all materials furnished
- 24 and services rendered, for the performance of the contract, and
- 25 that any person or corporation furnishing such materials or
- 26 rendering such services may maintain an action to recover for
- 27 the same against the obligor in the undertaking as though such
- 28 person or corporation was named therein, provided the action is
- 29 brought within one year after the time the cause of action
- 30 accrued. Nothing in this section shall be construed to limit the

- 1 power of the Authority to construct any project or portion
- 2 thereof or any addition, betterment or extension thereto,
- 3 directly by the officers, agents and employes of the Authority,
- 4 or otherwise than by contract.
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- Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 6
