AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581), 2 entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending
- and consolidating the law relating to boroughs, " authorizing
- 4 boroughs to enter into contracts with the Commonwealth for
- 5 police protection.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 1122 and clause (35) of section 1202, act
- 9 of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581), known as "The
- 10 Borough Code, " are amended to read:
- 11 Section 1122. Police Serving Under Cooperative Agreement or
- 12 Contract. -- Whenever any borough shall have entered into a
- 13 cooperative agreement or contract with the Commonwealth or any
- 14 near or adjacent city, borough, or township for the furnishing
- 15 or receiving of police protection, as authorized by clause (35)
- 16 of section 1202 of this act, such policemen, individually, shall
- 17 be appointed and accepted as policemen of the borough receiving
- 18 such police service by resolution of the council of the said
- 19 borough. Policemen so appointed shall, however, in so far as

- 1 civil service and pensions are concerned, be deemed to be
- 2 appointees and employes only of the Commonwealth or of the
- 3 municipality or township furnishing their service and making the
- 4 original appointment thereof.
- 5 Section 1202. Specific Powers. -- The powers of the borough
- 6 shall be vested in the corporate authorities. Among the specific
- 7 powers of the borough shall be the following, and in the
- 8 exercise of any of such powers involving the enactment of any
- 9 ordinance or the making of any regulation, restriction or
- 10 prohibition, the borough may provide for the enforcement thereof
- 11 and may prescribe penalties for the violation thereof or for the
- 12 failure to conform thereto:
- 13 * * *
- 14 (35) Joint contracts for police and fire protection. To
- 15 enter into contracts with the proper authorities of the
- 16 <u>Commonwealth or of</u> near or adjacent cities, boroughs, or
- 17 townships, either for mutual aid or assistance in police and
- 18 fire protection, or for the furnishing to or, receiving from,
- 19 the Commonwealth, such cities, boroughs, or townships, aid and
- 20 assistance in police and fire protection, and to make
- 21 appropriations therefor: Provided, That in connection with such
- 22 contracts, it shall not be necessary to advertise for bids or
- 23 receive bonds as required for other contracts under existing
- 24 law. When any such contract has been entered into the police,
- 25 firemen or fire police of the Commonwealth or of the employing
- 26 city, borough or township shall have all the powers and
- 27 authority conferred by law on city, borough or township police,
- 28 firemen, or fire police in the territory of the city, borough or
- 29 township which has contracted to secure such service. Any police
- 30 protection furnished by agreement with the Commonwealth shall be

- 1 <u>in addition to any existing, full-time police protection</u>
- 2 provided by the borough.
- 3 * * *
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
