## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 1, 1956 (P.L.1959, No.657), entitled, 1 as amended, "An act fixing the salaries and compensation of 2 3 the Chief Justice and judges of the Supreme Court, the 4 President Judge and judges of the Superior Court, the judges of the courts of common pleas, the judges of the orphans' 5 6 courts, the judges of the County Court of Philadelphia and 7 the judges of the County Court and Juvenile Court of Allegheny County, certain associate judges not learned in the 8 9 law, certain state officers, and the salary and expenses of 10 the members of the General Assembly, and repealing certain 11 inconsistent acts," further providing for the salaries of 12 justices and judges of the various courts.

13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

14 hereby enacts as follows:

15 Section 1. Sections 2 and 3, act of June 1, 1956 (P.L.1959, 16 No.657), entitled, as amended, "An act fixing the salaries and compensation of the Chief Justice and judges of the Supreme 17 Court, the President Judge and judges of the Superior Court, the 18 judges of the courts of common pleas, the judges of the orphans' 19 20 courts, the judges of the County Court of Philadelphia and the 21 judges of the County Court and Juvenile Court of Allegheny County, certain associate judges not learned in the law, certain 22

state officers, and the salary and expenses of the members of the General Assembly, and repealing certain inconsistent acts," amended January 26, 1966 (1965 P.L.1602, No.565) and by the November 1972 report of the Commonwealth Compensation Commission, are amended to read:

6 Section 2. The annual salary of the Chief Justice of the
7 Supreme Court shall be [\$52,500] <u>\$57,500</u>, and the annual salary
8 of each of the associate judges of the Supreme Court shall be
9 [\$50,000] <u>\$55,000</u>.

10 Section 3. The annual salary of the President Judge of the 11 Superior Court shall be [\$49,500] <u>\$54,500</u> and the annual salary 12 of each of the associate judges of the Superior Court shall be 13 [\$48,000] <u>\$53,000</u>.

Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read: Section 3.1. The annual salary of the President Judge of the Commonwealth Court shall be [\$49,500] <u>\$54,500</u>. The annual salary of each of the associate judges of the Commonwealth Court shall be [\$48,000] <u>\$53,000</u>.

Section 3. Section 4 of the act, amended January 26, 1966 (1965 P.L.1602, No.565) and by the November 1972 report of the Commonwealth Compensation Commission is amended to read: Section 4. (a) The annual salary of a president judge of a court of common pleas shall be fixed in accordance with the following schedule:
