4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
б	Section 1. Section 1331 of Title 18, act of November 25,
7	1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes, added December 30, 1974 (No.345), is amended to read:
9	§ 1331. Requirement for presentence investigation and report.
10	Before sentencing a person convicted of a felony of the first
11	degree or before sentencing any defendant to one year or longer,
12	a presentence investigation and report shall be made, unless the
13	sentence is death or a mandatory sentence to life imprisonment,
14	or unless, if the conviction was for an offense other than a
15	felony of the first degree, the court specifically orders to the
16	contrary. The report shall be made within 30 days from the date
17	of conviction of defendant or within such greater period of time
18	as the court shall direct.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
