AN ACT

- 1 Defining the words "nominal bail" to mean bail of one thousand 2 dollars.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Whenever in any law or rule of court the words

6 "nominal bail" appear they shall be deemed to mean bail of

7 \$1,000 except when used with reference to summary offenses.

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
