## AN ACT

1 2	Amending the act of December 22, 1959 (P.L.1978, No.728), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for and regulating	
3	harness racing with pari-mutuel wagering on the results	
4 5	thereof; creating the State Harness Racing Commission as a departmental administrative commission within the Department	
6	of Agriculture and defining its powers and duties; providing	
7	for the establishment and operation of harness racing plants	
8	subject to local option; imposing taxes on revenues of such	
9	plants; disposing of all moneys received by the commission	
.0	and all moneys collected from the taxes; authorizing	
.1	penalties; and making appropriations, "further providing for	
.2	lost, misplaced or stolen tickets. and further providing for	<
.3	the disposition of certain funds.	
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania	
.5	hereby enacts as follows:	
.6	Section 1. Clause (3) of subsection (b) of section 2, act of

- 19 Section 2. General Powers of State Harness Racing

- 21 (b) Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, and in
- 22 addition to its other powers:

- 2 (3) The rules of the commission shall also provide that all
- 3 winning pari-mutuel tickets must be presented for payment before
- 4 April first of the year following the year of their purchase and
- 5 failure to present any such ticket within the prescribed period
- 6 of time shall constitute a waiver of the right to participate in
- 7 the award or dividend. After April first of the year following,
- 8 all licensees will forward to the State Treasurer all funds so
- 9 held for such uncashed tickets.
- 10 Where it is shown to the satisfaction of the racing
- 11 commission and the Department of Revenue, through substantiated
- 12 and recorded data, that the reason for the pari-mutuel ticket or
- 13 tickets being outstanding and unclaimed is the loss,
- 14 misplacement or theft of said ticket or tickets within the
- 15 confines and control of the pari-mutuel department of any permit
- 16 holder, and it is further shown to the satisfaction of the
- 17 racing commission and the Department of Revenue that the pari-
- 18 mutuel ticket or tickets in question have been cashed by the
- 19 pari-mutuel department, the Department of Revenue, with the
- 20 approval of the racing commission, may adjust and credit the
- 21 permit holder's outstanding ticket account accordingly on March
- 22 31 of the year following the year of purchase or after a
- 23 complete audit of the outstanding tickets accounts have been
- 24 performed, and the permit holder shall reimburse any employe who
- 25 has been held personally accountable and paid for such lost,
- 26 <u>misplaced or stolen ticket or tickets.</u>

- 30 Section 16. Disposition and Appropriation of Funds Accruing

- 1 under the Provisions of this Act. \* \* \*
- 2 (d) The balance of said moneys shall be paid into a fund
- 3 known as the Pennsylvania Fair Fund. Moneys in the Pennsylvania
- 4 Fair Fund are hereby appropriated to the Department of
- 5 Agriculture and shall be distributed by the Secretary of
- 6 Agriculture, annually, on or before the first day of March
- 7 beginning with the year 1968, as follows:

- 9 (3) For reimbursement for each county agricultural society
- 10 and independent agricultural society conducting races for two
- 11 and three year old colts and fillies, at their annual fair on
- 12 which a maximum of [seven hundred dollars (\$700)] six thousand
- 13 <u>dollars (\$6,000)</u> was paid [for each such race but not more than
- 14 fifty six hundred dollars (\$5,600)] for the total number of
- 15 <u>races which shall be not more than eight such races</u> annually.
- 16 Entrance fees collected for each such race shall not be included
- 17 when computing the amount distributed by the Secretary of
- 18 Agriculture under this subsection.
