## AN ACT

Amending the act of December 11, 1967 (P.L.707, No.331), 2 entitled "An act providing for and regulating thoroughbred 3 horse racing with pari-mutuel wagering on the results thereof, creating the State Horse Racing Commission as an 5 independent administrative commission and defining its powers 6 and duties; providing for the establishment and operation of 7 thoroughbred horse racing plants; imposing taxes on revenues of such plants; disposing of all moneys received by the commission and all moneys collected from the taxes; 9 authorizing penalties; and making appropriations, providing 10 11 for free admissions to races. 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. The act of December 11, 1967 (P.L.707, No.331), referred to as the State Horse Racing Law, is amended by adding 15 16 a section to read: Section 23.1. Free Admission. -- Notwithstanding any other 17 18 provision of this act, a corporation licensed to conduct parimutual betting on thoroughbred horse races may provide for the 19 20 free admission of all persons to the race track: Provided, however, That the tax imposed by section 6 shall continue to be 21

- 1 <u>collected on each admission except on admissions of those</u>
- 2 persons listed under section 23.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
