- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, further defining "emergency vehicles."
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 5 Section 1. The definition of "emergency vehicle" in section
- 6 102, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, added June 17, 1976 (No.81),
- 8 is amended to read:
- 9 § 102. Definitions.
- 10 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
- 11 provisions of this title which are applicable to specific
- 12 provisions of this title, the following words and phrases when
- 13 used in this title shall have, unless the content clearly
- 14 indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section:
- 15 \* \* \*
- 16 "Emergency vehicle." A fire department vehicle, police
- 17 vehicle, ambulance, blood-delivery vehicle, armed forces
- 18 emergency vehicle, one private vehicle of a fire or police chief

- 1 or assistant chief or ambulance corps or rescue organization
- 2 commander or assistant commander [or of a river rescue
- 3 commander] used for answering emergency calls or other vehicle
- 4 designated by the State Police under section 6106 (relating to
- 5 designation of emergency vehicles by Pennsylvania State Police).

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
