AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172, No.290), entitled
2 "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and
3 incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their
4 construction and maintenance at the expense of the
5 Commonwealth," deleting Route 06039 in Sinking Springs
6 Borough in Berks County.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. The following route established by section 2, act
10 of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172, No.290), entitled "An act
11 establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns
12 as State highways, and providing for their construction and
13 maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," is deleted as
14 indicated:

15 Section 2. The streets taken over under the authority of
16 this act are situate and described, as follows:

18 BERKS COUNTY

19 * * *

20 Sinking Springs Borough

1 [Route 06039; Traffic Route 174. Extending Route 06039.--
2 Beginning at a point on the Sinking Springs Borough-Spring
3 Township line, thence in a southwesterly direction on Mull
4 Avenue to a point of intersection with Legislative Route 149,
5 Station 1181+38, at Mull and Penn Avenues, in the borough of
6 Sinking Springs, Berks County, a distance of about .38 of a
7 mile.]

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
