## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 71 (State Government) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, revising provisions relating to
- 3 retirement for State employees and officers in connection
- with assignment of funds. 4
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 5953 of Title 71, act
- 8 of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the
- Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, amended October 5, 1975 (No. 9
- 10 101), is amended to read:
- 11 Taxation, attachment and assignment of funds.
- 12
- 13 (b) Authorized payments from fund. -- The board shall be
- 14 authorized to pay from the fund:
- 15 In the case of a member who is terminating service,
- 16 the amount determined after certification by the head of the
- 17 department that the member is so obligated, and after review
- 18 and approval by the department or agency's legal
- 19 representative or upon receipt of an assignment from the

- 1 member in the amount so certified.
- 2 (2) In the case of a loan the amount of the loan and any
- 3 fine or interest due thereon to the credit union except 5% of
- 4 the total amount due which is to be retained in the fund as a
- 5 collection fee:
- 6 (i) if the member obtaining the loan shall have been
- 7 in default in required payments for a period of not less
- 8 than two years; or
- 9 (ii) at such time as the Department of Banking shall
- 10 require the credit union to charge the amount of the loan
- 11 against the reserve fund of such credit union.
- 12 Any member who shall have pledged such rights as security for
- a loan from a credit union and, on whose behalf the board
- shall have made any payment by reason of that member's
- default, may not thereafter pledge or assign such rights to a
- 16 credit union.
- 17 The board may grant a person a waiver from the provisions of
- 18 this subsection if warranted by extenuating circumstances
- 19 whenever he agrees to continuous and automatic payroll
- 20 deductions for the payment of the obligation due the credit
- 21 union.
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
