AN ACT

1 Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An  
2 act concerning townships of the second class; and amending,  
3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating  
4 thereto," further providing for the number of meetings for  
5 which supervisors may be compensated.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 512, act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69),  
9 known as "The Second Class Township Code," reenacted and amended  
10 July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567), and amended September 2, 1965  
11 (P.L.481, No.243), is amended to read:

12 Section 512. Monthly Meetings; Quorum, Rent and Expenses.--  
13 The township supervisors shall meet for the transaction of  
14 business at least once each month, at a time and place to be  
15 fixed by the board, but they shall not be paid for more than  
16 sixteen meetings in any one year, except in any township where,  
17 on account of the exercise of governmental functions other than  
18 those relating to roads, more meetings are necessary, in which

1 case, the number of meetings for which the supervisors may be  
2 paid may be increased to any number, not exceeding [twenty-four  
3 in any year, in townships having a population of five thousand  
4 or less, and in townships having more than five thousand  
5 population not exceeding] fifty meetings in any year WHICH SHALL <—  
6 INCLUDE HEARINGS BY AGGRIEVED PARTIES UNDER THE SEWAGE  
7 FACILITIES ACT AND OTHER HEARINGS OF A JUDICIAL OR QUASI-  
8 JUDICIAL NATURE. Two members of any board of supervisors  
9 consisting of three members shall constitute a quorum and three  
10 members of any board of supervisors consisting of five members  
11 shall constitute a quorum. Except as otherwise provided in this  
12 act, an affirmative vote of a majority of the entire board of  
13 supervisors shall be necessary in order to transact any  
14 business. Necessary expenses incurred in such meetings,  
15 including office rent, stationery, light and fuel, shall be paid  
16 out of the general township fund.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
