SENATOR CIANFRANI, APPROPRIATIONS, AS AMENDED, JUNE 30, 1975

AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation to the Philadelphia College of
- Osteopathic Medicine, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The sum of \$3,494,000, \$3,511,000, or as much
- 6 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated
- 7 to the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine,
- 8 Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for its fiscal period July 1, 1975
- 9 to June 30, 1976, for instruction in the Doctor of Osteopathy
- 10 program.
- 11 Section 2. Payments to the Philadelphia College of
- 12 Osteopathic Medicine, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, on account of
- 13 the appropriation for instruction in the Doctor of Osteopathy
- 14 program as provided in section 1 shall be made on the basis of
- 15 full-time student enrollment at the rate of \$4,400 per student.
- 16 Section 3. The Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine,
- 17 Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, shall provide such information and
- 18 in such form and manner as the Department of Education may

- 1 prescribe.
- 2 Section 4. The Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine,
- 3 Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, shall report its revenues and
- 4 expenditures and present its financial statements in accordance
- 5 with generally accepted accounting principles and procedures for
- 6 educational institutions as set forth in the "Industry Audit
- 7 Guide for Colleges and Universities" of the American Institute
- 8 of Certified Public Accountants of 1973 without exception.
- 9 Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
