AN ACT

1 Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, NO.69), entitled "An
2 act concerning townships of the second class; and amending,
3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating
4 thereto," further providing for the compensation of the
5 township treasurer.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 531, act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69),
9 known as "The Second Class Township Code," reenacted and amended
10 July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567), and amended June 6, 1963
11 (P.L.69, No.46), is amended to read:

12 Section 531. Compensation.--The township treasurer shall
13 receive, as compensation for his services, salary, wages or a
14 certain percentage on all moneys received and paid by him, which
15 compensation shall be determined by the supervisors of the
16 townships.

17 Except as otherwise provided in section 540 hereof, the
18 amount paid to the treasurer as treasurer and secretary, shall
19 [not exceed three per centum of the money paid out by the

1 treasurer, but it shall not be less than fifty dollars; and the
2 calculation of such maximum compensation shall not include any
3 percentage upon money paid out by the treasurer for the
4 repayment of loans, notes, certificates, or other evidences of
5 indebtedness, or other borrowed moneys.] be determined by the
6 board of supervisors, except that where a supervisor is serving
7 as secretary and/or treasurer the auditors shall fix the
8 compensation.

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
