## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, exempting totally and permanently disabled
- 3 veterans from payment of real property taxes in certain
- 4 cases.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby resolves as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 8 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with
- 9 the provisions of Article XI thereof:
- 10 That subsection (c) of section 2, Article VIII be amended to
- 11 read:
- 12 § 2. Exemptions and special provisions. --\* \* \*
- 13 (c) Citizens and residents of this Commonwealth, who served
- 14 in any war or armed conflict in which the United States was
- 15 engaged and were honorably discharged or released under
- 16 honorable circumstances from active service, shall be exempt
- 17 from the payment of all real property taxes upon the residence
- 18 occupied by the said citizens and residents of this Commonwealth
- 19 imposed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any of its

- political subdivisions if, as a result of military service, they 1
- 2 are blind, paraplegic or double or quadruple amputees or have a
- 3 <u>service-connected disability declared by the United States</u>
- <u>Veterans' Administration or its successor to be a total or 100%</u> 4
- 5 permanent disability, and if the State Veterans' Commission
- determines that such persons are in need of the tax exemptions 6
- 7 granted herein.
