б	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 2, act of July 19, 1974 (P.L.486,
8	No.175), referred to as the Public Agency Open Meeting Law, is
9	amended to read:
10	Section 2. The meetings or hearings of every agency at which
11	formal action is scheduled or taken are public meetings and
12	shall be open to the public at all times. No formal action shall
13	be valid unless such formal action is taken during a public
14	meeting and unless such formal action is taken by an open and
15	public ballot. The names and the votes of those voting shall be
16	recorded in the minutes of the meeting and such records shall be
17	available to the public pursuant to section 4. The use of secret
18	ballots or other such devices to conceal the manner in which the
19	votes were made is prohibited.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
