AN ACT

Amending the act of May 21, 1976 (No.6-A), entitled "A supplement to the act of June 4, 1976 (No.7-A), entitled 'An 2 3 act to provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt 5 and for the public schools for the fiscal period July 1, 1976 to June 30, 1977, and for the payment of bills incurred and 7 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1976, 'itemizing appropriations required from the 8 9 Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund for the proper operations 10 of the several departments of the Commonwealth authorized to spend Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund moneys, " increasing 11 12 certain appropriations. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 14 15 Section 1. Section 2, act of May 21, 1976 (No.6-A), known as 16 the "Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund Supplement to the General Appropriation Act of 1976," vetoed in part, is amended 17 18 by increasing certain appropriations made to the Department of Education, the Department of Environmental Resources, the 19 20 Department of Health, and the Judicial Department to read: 21 Section 2. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be 22 necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the Federal

Revenue Sharing Trust Fund for the fiscal period July 1, 1976 to

28	II. JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT

30	For the payment to the counties in reimbursement
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- 1 of the direct costs incurred by the counties in the
- 2 administration and operation of all courts established
- 3 pursuant to Article V, section 1 of the Pennsylvania
- 4 Constitution and for offices of justices and judges
- 5 of the Supreme, Superior and Commonwealth Courts
- 6 in the county of their residence. Costs incurred
- 7 by the counties in the administration and operation
- 8 of all courts means costs as reported to the Depart-
- 9 ment of Community Affairs in the county's annual
- 10 financial report forms under the heading (a) "Judicial,"
- 11 but confined to the subheading: (160) Courts,
- 12 excluding capital outlay. If a city coterminous
- 13 with a county does not report on the Department of
- 14 Community Affairs' form, its figures from the same
- 15 subheading, set forth in the department forms,
- 16 shall be used: Provided, That such payments shall
- 17 be made to the County Treasurer and in cities of the
- 18 first class coterminous with counties of the first
- 19 class to the City Treasurer: And, provided further,
- 20 That in the event the amount herein appropriated is
- 21 not sufficient to reimburse all such costs, payments
- 22 shall be made to the counties in the proportion
- 23 which the costs of each county bears to the total
- 24 costs of all counties during the most recently
- 25 completed fiscal year: And provided further,
- 26 That in making allocations and payments hereunder,
- 27 the Court Administrator of Pennsylvania shall,
- 28 except for county offices of justices and judges
- 29 of the Supreme, Superior and Commonwealth Courts,
- 30 exclude all costs which are not properly reportable
