## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 71 (State Government) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, denying retirement benefits to certain
- 3 persons convicted of certain crimes.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 71, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
- 7 No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is
- 8 amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 5312. Denial of certain benefits.
- 10 Any member who is convicted of any felony or any crime
- 11 involving moral turpitude in connection with his official duties
- 12 as an officer or employee of the State shall not receive any
- 13 retirement benefits. Said member only shall be entitled to
- 14 receive his salary deductions together with any statutory
- 15 interest thereon.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
