AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, adding a penalty provision.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Section 3503(b)(2) of Title 18, act of November  
6 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes, is amended to read:

8 § 3503. Criminal trespass.

10 (b) Defiant trespasser.--

12 (2) An offense under this subsection constitutes a  
13 misdemeanor of the third degree if the offender defies an  
14 order to leave personally communicated to him by the owner of  
15 the premises or other authorized person. Otherwise it is a  
16 summary offense for which the minimum fine shall be \$100.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
