AN ACT

Amending the act of November 26, 1976 (No.55-A), entitled "An act to further provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for 3 the fiscal period July 1, 1976 to June 30, 1977; to make additional appropriations from the Federal augmentation to 5 6 the Executive Department for the fiscal period July 1, 1976 7 to June 30, 1977, and to appropriate the Federal funds available for implementation of Title II, Public Law 94-369, 8 to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive 9 Department, " changing and adding appropriations and making 10 11 editorial changes. 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Part IV PARTS I, III, IV AND VI of section 2, act <--15 of November 26, 1976 (No.55-A), known as the "Supplemental Appropriation Act of 1976," is ARE amended by changing, adding 16 17 and correcting items to read: 18 Section 2.
