REPRESENTATIVES, AS AMENDED, APRIL 25, 1977

AN ACT

1 Amending the act of November 26, 1976 (No.55-A), entitled "An
2 act to further provide for the expenses of the Executive,
3 Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for
4 the fiscal period July 1, 1976 to June 30, 1977; to make
5 additional appropriations from the Federal augmentation to
6 the Executive Department for the fiscal period July 1, 1976
7 to June 30, 1977, and to appropriate the Federal funds
8 available for implementation of Title II, Public Law 94-369,
9 to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive
10 Department," changing and adding appropriations and making
11 editorial changes.

12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
13 hereby enacts as follows:

14 Section 1. ~~Part IV~~ PARTS I, III, IV AND VI of section 2, act <—
15 of November 26, 1976 (No.55-A), known as the "Supplemental
16 Appropriation Act of 1976," ~~is~~ ARE amended by changing, adding <—

7 for the purposes hereinafter set forth for the fiscal period
8 beginning July 1, 1976 and for the payment of bills incurred and
9 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June
10 30, 1976.

9 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY HEREBY APPROPRIATES [\$16,060,000]
10 \$23,841,379 OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE NECESSARY, FROM THE
11 FEDERAL FUNDS AVAILABLE IN THE GENERAL FUND FOR IMPLEMENTATION
12 OF TITLE II, PUBLIC LAW 94-369, KNOWN AS THE "PUBLIC WORKS
13 EMPLOYMENT ACT OF 1976," TO THE SEVERAL HEREINAFTER NAMED
14 AGENCIES OF THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT OF THE COMMONWEALTH FOR THE
15 PAYMENT OF EXPENSES OF IMPLEMENTING AND CARRYING OUT THE
16 PROGRAMS STATED HEREIN FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1,
