## AN ACT

Amending the act of October 10, 1974 (P.L.705, No.235), entitled "An act providing for the training and licensing of watch guards, protective patrolmen, detectives and criminal investigators, carrying and using lethal weapons in their employment; imposing powers and duties on the Commissioner of the Pennsylvania State Police; and providing penalties," exempting certain retired police officers from the provisions of this act.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The definition of "privately employed agents" of section 3, act of October 10, 1974 (P.L.705, No.235), known as the "Lethal Weapons Training Act," amended November 23, 1976 (No.254), is amended to read:

Section 3. Definitions.--As used in this act:
"Privately employed agents" include any person employed for the purpose of providing watch guard, protective patrol, detective or criminal investigative services either for another for a fee or for his employer. Privately employed agents do not include local, State or Federal Government employees or those police officers commissioned by the Governor under the act of
February 27, 1865 (P.L.225, No.228). The term privately employed
agents shall not include retired police officers of a
municipality, a township or the State Police if such officer was
a full-time officer for twenty years and retired in good
standing.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
