8	Section 1. Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
9	No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is

12	(a) DefinitionsAs used in this section the following
13	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
14	subsection:
15	"Child." Any individual who has not attained the age of 16.
16	"Prohibited sexual conduct." The term means and applies to
17	all forms of sexual intercourse, and intercourse, masturbation,

1	<u>bestiality, sadism, masochism, fellatio, cunnilingus, any other</u>
2	sexual activity and nudity when such nudity is to be depicted
3	for the purposes of sexual stimulation or gratification of any
4	individual who may view such nude depiction.
5	(b) Engagement in prohibited sexual actA person commits a
6	felony of the first degree if such person causes or knowingly
7	permits any child to engage in a prohibited sexual act or in the
8	simulation of a prohibited sexual act and such person knows, has
9	reason to know or intends that such prohibited act may be
10	photographed, drawing, sketched or filmed or that any photograph
11	drawing, sketch or film depicting such prohibited act may be
12	transported, shipped or mailed through intrastate commerce,
13	interstate commerce or foreign commerce or may affect intrastate
14	commerce, interstate commerce or foreign commerce.
15	(c) Depiction of prohibited sexual actA person commits a
16	felony of the first degree if such person photographs, draws,
17	sketches or films a child engaging in a prohibited sexual act or
18	in the simulation of a prohibited sexual act and such person
19	knows, has reason to know or intends that any photograph,
20	drawing, sketch or film made by such person depicting a
21	prohibited sexual act may be transported, shipped or mailed
22	through intrastate commerce, interstate commerce or foreign
23	commerce or may affect intrastate commerce, interstate commerce
24	<u>or foreign commerce.</u>
25	(d) Transportation of materials depicting prohibited sexual
26	actsA person commits a felony of the third degree if such
27	person knowingly transports, ships or mails through, or in any
28	manner as to affect, intrastate commerce, interstate commerce or
29	foreign commerce any photograph, drawing, sketch or film
30	depicting a child engaging in a prohibited sexual act or in the
