12	controller or county auditors [may] shall annually audit the	
13	accounts of every alderman, magistrate or <a href="DISTRICT">DISTRICT</a> justice [of	<
14	the peace] within the county and report the results of such	<
15	audits to the county commissioners, the Auditor General and to	
16	the governing body of each political subdivision which is	
17	entitled or has a right to receive any moneys or funds collected	
18	by any such alderman, magistrate or <a href="DISTRICT">DISTRICT</a> justice [of the	<
