- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting certain pseudo-religious
- 3 cults.
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4
- hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
- No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is 7
- 8 amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 7506. Pseudo-religious cults.
- 10 A person is quilty of a felony of the third degree if he
- 11 organizes or maintains an organization into which other persons
- are induced through the use of mind control methods, hypnosis, 12
- brainwashing techniques or other systematic forms of 13
- indoctrination, and the members engage in solicting funds 14
- primarily for the benefit of the organization or the leaders of 15
- 16 the organization, and the members are not permitted to travel or
- 17 communicate with anyone outside the organization unless another
- member of the organization is present. 18
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
