AN ACT

Amending the act of June 4, 1976 (P.L.1331, No.7-A), entitled "An act to provide for the expenses of the Executive, 3 Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal period 5 July 1, 1976 to June 30, 1977, and for the payment of bills 6 incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal 7 period ending June 30, 1976," increasing the appropriation to 8 the Department of Public Welfare for medical assistance AND PROVIDING FOR A CONTINUING APPROPRIATION TO PUBLIC LIBRARIES.

- 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 11 hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. As much of section 2 as relates to the Department 12
- 13 of Public Welfare as to medical assistance, act of June 4, 1976
- (P.L.1331, No.7-A), known as the "General Appropriation Act of 14
- 1976," is amended to read: 15
- 16 Section 2. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be
- 17 necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the General
- 18 Fund to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive,
- 19 Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for the
- 20 payment of the salaries, wages or other compensation and travel
- 21 expenses of the duly elected or appointed officers and employees

- 1 of the Commonwealth, for payment of fees of contractual services
- 2 rendered, for the purchase or rental of goods, services,
- 3 printing, equipment, land and buildings and for payment of any
- 4 other expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for
- 5 the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities and
- 6 for the purposes hereinafter set forth for the fiscal period
- 7 beginning July 1, 1976 and for the payment of bills incurred and
- 8 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June
- 9 30, 1976.

- 20 SECTION 2. SECTION 9 OF THE ACT IS AMENDED TO READ:
- 21 SECTION 9. (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (B) AND
- 22 (C), THAT PART OF ALL APPROPRIATIONS IN THIS ACT UNEXPENDED,
- 23 UNCOMMITTED AND UNENCUMBERED AS OF JUNE 30, 1977 SHALL
- 24 AUTOMATICALLY LAPSE AS OF THAT DATE.
- 25 (B) THAT PART OF THE APPROPRIATION TO THE PENNSYLVANIA
- 26 HISTORICAL AND MUSEUM COMMISSION FOR TEMPORARY CUSTODIAL AND
- 27 SECURITY PERSONNEL, AND MAINTENANCE AS MAY BE UNEXPENDED,
- 28 UNCOMMITTED AND UNENCUMBERED AS OF NOVEMBER 1, 1976 SHALL
- 29 AUTOMATICALLY LAPSE AS OF THAT DATE.
- 30 (C) THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE FOR

- 1 REIMBURSEMENT TO MUNICIPALITIES FOR BICENTENNIAL RELATED
- 2 MUNICIPAL OVERBURDEN AND THE APPROPRIATIONS TO THE LEGISLATIVE
- 3 DEPARTMENT AND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR GRANTS TO
- 4 <u>PUBLIC LIBRARIES</u> SHALL BE CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS.
- Section $\frac{2}{3}$. This act shall take effect immediately.
