AN ACT

1 Requiring certain professional schools to admit as many students
2 as possible.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. All medical, dental and veterinary schools
6 located within this Commonwealth shall upon admitting a first-
7 year class, admit as many students in that class as can be
8 accommodated by the facilities of the school.

9 Section 2. The Department of Education shall administer the
10 provisions of this act and shall annually report to the General
11 Assembly such data as will show the number of students in each
12 class and the facilities available for them.

13 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
