14	Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 1220 of the act of June
15	3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the "Pennsylvania Election

17	Section 1220. Regulations in Force at Polling Places* * *
18	(c) [No person, when within the polling place, shall
19	electioneer or solicit votes for any political party, political
20	body or candidate, nor shall any] <u>While the polls are open no</u>
21	person shall do any electioneering within the polling place, or
22	within one hundred feet therefrom in any public street, or
23	<u>within such distance in any place in a public manner. No</u> written

or printed matter shall be posted up within the said room, 1 2 except as required by this act. 3 For the purposes of this subsection, the one hundred foot distance shall be deemed to include a one hundred foot radial 4 5 measured from the entrances, designated by the judge of election, to a building where the primary, special or general 6 7 election is being held. * * * 8 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
