AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other 19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 20 commissions shall be determined, " requiring the installation 21 of flood monitoring systems in earthen dams.
- 22 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 23 hereby enacts as follows:
- 24 Section 1. Section 1904-A, act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177,
- 25 No.175), known as "The Administrative Code of 1929," is amended
- 26 by adding a clause to read:
- 27 Section 1904-A. Waters.--The Department of Environmental

- Resources shall have the power and its duty shall be:
- 2 * * *
- 3 (9) To install or require and oversee the installation of a
- 4 <u>flood monitoring system of the sensor type in all earthen dams</u>
- 5 which could cause loss of life or serious damage to property
- 6 should a failure of the dam occur. The department shall maintain
- 7 a current list of all such dams.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1978.
