AN ACT

Amending the act of October 10, 1974 (P.L.705, No.235), entitled "An act providing for the training and licensing of watch 3 guards, protective patrolmen, detectives and criminal investigators, carrying and using lethal weapons in their 5 employment; imposing powers and duties on the Commissioner of the Pennsylvania State Police; and providing penalties," 7 providing for a limited exemption from the educational 8 requirements for certification of certain qualified persons. 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. The act of October 10, 1974 (P.L.705, No.235), known as the "Lethal Weapons Training Act," is amended by adding 12 13 a section to read: Section 7.1. Limited Exemption. -- The commissioner shall 14 15 issue the appropriate completion certificate to a qualified individual without requiring such individual to fulfill the 16 requirements of section 4 relating to the mandatory attendance 17 of privately employed agents at certain prescribed courses of 18

- instruction if such individual, prior to employment as a private 1
- 2 agent, was employed as a full-time police officer for a period
- 3 of ten years or more in any municipality in the Commonwealth.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 4
