## AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled "An 2 act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and 3 brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and 4 5 restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession, 6 consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic 7 liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the 8 9 persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing 10 for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores, 11 for the payment of certain license fees to the respective 12 municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain 13 14 nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures; 15 providing for local option, and repealing existing laws," 16 17 prohibiting relatives of distributor licensees from 18 possessing such a license. 19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 20 21 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 438, act of April 12, 22 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), known as the "Liquor Code," is amended to 23 read: 24 Section 438. Number and Kinds of Licenses Allowed Same 25 Licensee.--\* \* \*
  - (b) No person shall possess or be issued more than one
