AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, by requiring road use tags for truck tractors and  
3 providing for fees and penalties.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 75, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,  
7 No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is  
8 amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 1960. Road use tags.

10 (a) Requirement.--No truck tractor shall be operated on any  
11 highway unless it has displayed thereon a road use tag issued by  
12 the department.

13 (b) Fee.--The fee for such tag shall be \$100 per year.

14 (c) Penalty.--Any person who operates a truck tractor on any  
15 highway not having displayed thereon a valid road use tag issued  
16 by the department shall, upon conviction thereof at a summary  
17 proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$200.

18 Section 2. (a) Effective date.--This act shall take effect

1 immediately.

2 (b) Application.--This act shall apply to the operation of  
3 truck tractors beginning January 1 of the second year following  
4 the year of final enactment.
