## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled "An act relating to the finances of the State government; 2 3 providing for the settlement, assessment, collection, and lien of taxes, bonus, and all other accounts due the 5 Commonwealth, the collection and recovery of fees and other 6 money or property due or belonging to the Commonwealth, or 7 any agency thereof, including escheated property and the 8 proceeds of its sale, the custody and disbursement or other disposition of funds and securities belonging to or in the 9 10 possession of the Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims against the Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and 11 appeals to the courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to 12 13 the Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth 14 and all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting 15 moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth and 16 17 imposing penalties; affecting every department, board, 18 commission, and officer of the State government, every 19 political subdivision of the State, and certain officers of 20 such subdivisions, every person, association, and corporation 21 required to pay, assess, or collect taxes, or to make returns 22 or reports under the laws imposing taxes for State purposes, or to pay license fees or other moneys to the Commonwealth, 23 24 or any agency thereof, every State depository and every 25 debtor or creditor of the Commonwealth, " authorizing the Auditor General to designate certain employes to have limited 26 27 powers of arrest.

- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 29 hereby enacts as follows:
- 30 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known
- 31 as "The Fiscal Code," is amended by adding a section to read:

- 1 Section 409. Special Investigators. -- The Auditor General
- shall issue commissions to such of the department's employes as 2
- 3 he shall designate to be special investigators. Such special
- 4 <u>investigators shall have the same powers of arrest as the</u>
- Pennsylvania State Police regarding violations of law relating 5
- to matters properly within the investigating or auditing powers 6
- 7 of the Auditor General.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
