REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON STATE GOVERNMENT, MARCH 13, 1978

AN ACT

1 Amending the act of January 10, 1968 (1967, P.L.925, No.417),  
2 entitled "An act relating to officers and employes of the  
3 General Assembly; fixing the number, qualifications,  
4 compensation, mileage and duties of the officers and employes  
5 of the Senate and of the House of Representatives; providing  
6 for their election or appointment, term of office, or of  
7 service, removal and manner of filling vacancies; fixing the  
8 salary of the Director of the Legislative Reference Bureau;  
9 providing for compilation of lists of employes," providing  
10 for the abolition of the following Senate offices: majority  
11 leader; minority leader; majority whip; majority caucus  
12 chairman; minority whip; minority caucus chairman; majority  
13 caucus secretary; minority caucus secretary; minority policy  
14 chairman; majority policy chairman; majority caucus  
15 administrator and minority caucus administrator and providing  
16 for the abolition of the following offices of the House of  
17 Representatives: majority leader; minority leader; majority  
18 whip; minority whip; majority caucus chairman; minority  
19 caucus chairman; majority caucus secretary; minority caucus  
20 secretary; minority policy chairman; majority policy  
21 chairman; majority caucus administrator and minority caucus  
22 administrator.

23 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
24 hereby enacts as follows:

25 Section 1. Sections 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 15.1,  
26 15.2 and 15.3, act of January 10, 1968 (1967, P.L.925, No.417),  
27 amended July 30, 1975 (P.L.121, No.60), referred to as the  
28 Legislative Officers and Employes Law, are repealed.

1       Section 2.   Section 16 of the act is amended to read:

2       Section 16.   The following officers of the Senate, in  
3   addition to their salaries as members of the General Assembly  
4   shall receive the following amounts as additional compensation:  
5   President pro tempore, ten thousand five hundred dollars  
6   (\$10,500)[; Majority Leader, eight thousand five hundred dollars  
7   (\$8,500); Majority Whip, four thousand dollars (\$4,000);  
8   Majority Caucus Chairman, three thousand five hundred dollars  
9   (\$3,500); Majority Caucus Secretary, two thousand dollars  
10   (\$2,000); Minority Leader, eight thousand five hundred dollars  
11   (\$8,500); Minority Whip, four thousand dollars (\$4,000);  
12   Minority Caucus Chairman, three thousand five hundred dollars  
13   (\$3,500); Minority Caucus Secretary, two thousand dollars  
14   (\$2,000); Minority Policy Chairman, two thousand dollars  
15   (\$2,000)].

16       Section 3.   Sections 16.1 and 16.2 of the act are repealed.

17       Section 4.   Sections 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33,  
18   33.1, 33.2 and 33.3 of the act are repealed.

19       Section 5.   Section 34 of the act is amended to read:

20       Section 34.   The following officers of the House of  
21   Representatives, in addition to their salaries as members of the  
22   General Assembly shall receive the following amounts as  
23   additional compensation: Speaker of the House, ten thousand five  
24   hundred dollars (\$10,500). [Majority Leader, eight thousand five  
25   hundred dollars (\$8,500); Majority Whip, four thousand dollars  
26   (\$4,000); Majority Caucus Chairman, three thousand five hundred  
27   dollars (\$3,500); Majority Caucus Secretary, two thousand  
28   dollars (\$2,000); Majority Policy Chairman, two thousand dollars  
29   (\$2,000); Majority Caucus Administrator, two thousand dollars  
30   (\$2,000); Minority Leader, eight thousand five hundred dollars

1 (\$8,500); Minority Whip, four thousand dollars (\$4,000);  
2 Minority Caucus Chairman, three thousand five hundred dollars  
3 (\$3,500); Minority Caucus Secretary, two thousand dollars  
4 (\$2,000); Minority Policy Chairman, two thousand dollars  
5 (\$2,000); Minority Caucus Administrator, two thousand dollars  
6 (\$2,000).]

7 Section 6. This act shall take effect on December 1, 1978.
