AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An
2 act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
3 welfare laws of the Commonwealth," providing for the
4 assignment of certain persons in the Pennsylvania Employables
5 Program to highway maintenance projects.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 405.1, act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31,
9 No.21), known as the "Public Welfare Code," is amended by adding
10 a subsection to read:

11 Section 405.1. Pennsylvania Employables Program.--* * *

12 (i) Persons registered pursuant to this section who are not
13 employed or who are not participating in work experience or
14 training programs shall be assigned to a State or local highway
15 maintenance project for a monthly average of four eight hour
16 days per week. The department shall permit employables to be
17 excused from work for a reasonable period of time for the
18 purpose of employment interviews and for other bona fide reasons
19 as the department shall determine. The Departments of Public

1 Welfare and Transportation shall jointly make such rules and
2 regulations as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of
3 this subsection and the Department of Public Welfare shall, in
4 cooperation with the Department of Transportation, develop
5 agreements with other prime sponsors in the Commonwealth under
6 the Federal Comprehensive Employment and Training Assistance
7 Program to assist in carrying out the purposes of this
8 subsection.

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
