AN ACT

1 Amending the act of May 2, 1945 (P.L.401, No.165), entitled, as  
2 amended, "An act defining and providing for the licensing and  
3 regulation of private trade schools and classes; conferring  
4 powers and imposing duties on the State Board of Private  
5 Trade Schools; and prescribing penalties," changing certain  
6 provisions to provide equal rights between men and women.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Clause (1) of section 1, act of May 2, 1945  
10 (P.L.401, No.165), entitled, as amended, "An act defining and  
11 providing for the licensing and regulation of private trade  
12 schools and classes; conferring powers and imposing duties on  
13 the State Board of Private Trade Schools; and prescribing  
14 penalties," amended May 9, 1949 (P.L.1008, No.292), is amended  
15 to read:

16 Section 1. The following words and phrases of this act shall  
17 have the meanings ascribed to them--

18 (1) "Private Trade School" or "school" shall mean a school

1 maintained or classes conducted for the purpose of offering  
2 instruction for a consideration, profit or tuition, the purpose  
3 of which is to prepare an individual to pursue a recognized  
4 profitable occupation in the skilled trades or industries, or to  
5 give occupational training. "Private Trade School" or "school"  
6 shall not include any school maintained or class conducted, (I)  
7 For training for the vocation of home making, [to women and  
8 girls] or (II) to give training in public and other service  
9 occupations, nor shall the terms include correspondence schools,  
10 business schools, private academic schools, barber schools,  
11 beauty culture schools, flight schools, or degree granting  
12 institutions.

14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
