AN ACT

1 Amending the act of December 21, 1977 (P.L.520, No.15A),
2 entitled "An act making an appropriation to the Governor for
3 disaster relief and assistance for the Great Flood of July
4 1977," to further provide for allocations of appropriations
5 by the Governor.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. The title and sections 1 and 2, act of December
9 21, 1977 (P.L.520, No.15A), entitled "An act making an
10 appropriation to the Governor for disaster relief and assistance
11 for the Great Flood of July 1977," are amended to read:

12 AN ACT

13 Making an appropriation to the Governor, and further providing
14 for allocations of appropriations by the Governor for
15 disaster relief and assistance for the Great Flood of July
16 1977.

17 Section 1. (a) The sum of \$4,000,000, or as much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Governor for
19 allocation by the Governor to provide disaster relief and

1 assistance for victims of the Great Flood of July, 1977.

2 (b) The appropriation for disaster relief and assistance for
3 victims of the Great Flood of July 1977, made pursuant to the
4 act of August 20, 1977 (P.L.411, No.11A), known as the "General
5 Appropriation Act of 1977," and the allocation of such funds by
6 the act of April 28, 1978 (No.51), entitled "An act providing
7 for grants to persons for property damaged or destroyed by
8 flood, establishing the basis for grants, and making an
9 appropriation," are hereby reappropriated to and may be
10 allocated by the Governor for disaster relief and assistance for
11 victims of the Great Flood of July 1977; and such appropriation
12 is in addition to the funds appropriated in subsection (a).

13 Section 2. All funds appropriated or reappropriated herein
14 which remain unexpended, uncommitted or unencumbered as of June
15 30, [1978] 1979 shall automatically lapse as of that date.

16 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:

17 Section 2.1. Section 4, act of April 28, 1978 (No.51),
18 entitled "An act providing for grants to persons for property
19 damaged or destroyed by flood, establishing the basis for the
20 grants, and making an appropriation," is repealed.

21 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
