- 12 <u>in addition to any other moneys the district is entitled to.</u>
- 13 (2) "State mandated program or activity" means any program
- 14 or activity which is imposed without choice on all or a portion
- 15 of all local school districts by acts of the General Assembly or
- 16 by regulations and policies of the Department of Education.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. Section
- 18 2554(a) shall apply to all programs mandated after the effective
- 19 date of this act and section 2554(b) shall apply to all mandated
- 20 programs.
