5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 4402, act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932,
8	No.317), known as "The Third Class City Code," reenacted and
9	amended June 28, 1951 (P.L.662, No.164), is amended to read:
10	Section 4402. Appointment of Examining BoardsThere shall
11	be the following civil service boards in each city: (a) A board
12	for the examination of applicants for appointment to any
13	position in the police department; (b) a board for the
14	examination of applicants for appointment as health officers
15	other than registered physicians, or as sanitary policemen or
16	inspectors of the health department; (c) a board for the
17	examination of applicants for appointment to any position in the
18	engineering or electrical departments, except as otherwise
19	provided for by law, or to the position of building inspectors.

Each of said boards shall consist of three citizens, who 1 shall be elected by council for terms of four years or until 2 3 their successors are elected and qualified. [One of the members of the boards, provided for in clauses (a) and (b) of this 4 section, shall be an educator and one shall be a physician.] Any 5 person who is a registered elector of the city may be appointed 6 to one or more of said boards. No city officer, official or 7 8 employe shall be eligible for appointment to any civil service 9 board.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
