A SUPPLEMENT

1 To the act of (P.L. , No.), entitled "An act to
2 provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and
3 Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt,
4 and for the public schools for the fiscal period July 1, 1977
5 to June 30, 1978, and for the payment of bills incurred and
6 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending
7 June 30, 1977," itemizing appropriations required from the
8 Motor License Fund for the proper operation of the several
9 departments of the Commonwealth authorized to spend Motor
10 License Fund moneys.

11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12 hereby enacts as follows:

13 Section 1. This supplement shall be known and may be cited
14 as the "Motor License Fund Supplement to the General
15 Appropriation Act of 1977."

16 Section 2. The following sums or as much thereof as may be
17 necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the Motor
18 License Fund to the hereinafter named agencies of the
19 Commonwealth for the payment of salaries, wages and other
20 compensation and travel expenses of the duly elected or
21 appointed officers and employees of the Commonwealth, for
22 contractual services and other expenses necessary for the proper

1 conduct of the duties, functions and activities for the purposes
2 hereinafter set forth for the fiscal period beginning July 1,
3 1977 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid
4 at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1977.

5 To the Department of Transportation

6 For the salaries, wages and all necessary
7 expenses for the proper administration of the
8 Department of Transportation, including the
9 Transportation Commission and Advisory Committee,
10 and the Statewide coordination of municipal
11 services..... \$ 21,220,000

12 For the salaries, wages and all necessary
13 expenses for the operation of the highway and
14 safety construction programs, including planning
15 and research, design, engineering, right-of-way
16 acquisition and the operation of the engineering
17 district facilities and liaison services with
18 communities on local road engineering and
19 construction activities..... 58,348,000

20 For the salaries, wages and all necessary
21 expenses for the administration and operation
22 of the maintenance program for State roads,
23 bridges, tunnels, and structures, including
24 the operation of the county maintenance district
25 facilities..... 366,658,000

26 For the salaries, wages and all necessary
27 expenses for the administration of the traffic
28 safety program and the administration and
29 operation of the operator and vehicle
30 registration programs..... 42,742,000

1 For payment from the restricted revenue
 2 account for aviation fuel taxes and airport
 3 operations revenue, for aviation operations
 4 including the operation and maintenance of
 5 State-owned aircraft, payment of general expenses,
 6 supplies, printing and equipment; for the
 7 development and maintenance of State airports
 8 and the maintenance and repair of landing fields,
 9 intermediate landing fields, landing field
 10 equipment, beacon sites, other navigation
 11 facilities, and the encouragement and development
 12 of civil aeronautics..... 4,407,000
 13 For rental payments to the State Highway and
 14 Bridge Authority for projects constructed with
 15 funds borrowed by the Authority..... 35,500,000
 16 For payments to municipalities to assist in
 17 maintenance and construction costs of roads in
 18 accordance with the act of June 1, 1956
 19 (P.L.1944, No.655), relative to the allocation
 20 of highway funds..... 87,275,000
 21 For payment from the restricted revenue
 22 account for aviation fuel taxes for airport
 23 construction and development including
 24 encouragement and development of aeronautics,
 25 development of State airports, assistance to
 26 political subdivisions and municipal authorities
 27 in the construction and improvement of airports
 28 and other aeronautical improvement of airports
 29 and other aeronautical facilities..... 1,511,000
 30 No more shall be expended from this item for

1 such purpose or any of them than may be required
2 to match an equal sum contributed by any political
3 subdivision, or municipality authority of the
4 Commonwealth or by the Federal Government, or by
5 a political subdivision or municipality authority
6 and the Federal Government as provided in the act
7 of May 2, 1947 (P.L.136, No.56), entitled "An act
8 relating to Federal aid to political subdivision
9 or municipality authority for the development of
10 public airports."

11 To the Treasury Department

12 For the payment of replacement checks issued
13 in lieu of outstanding checks when presented and
14 to adjust errors..... 50,000

15 For payment of refunds of liquid fuels taxes
16 for agricultural use to which the Commonwealth
17 is not entitled..... 5,500,000

18 For the payment of salaries, wages and all
19 necessary expenses in the proper administration
20 of the program to refund liquid fuels taxes for
21 agricultural use to which the Commonwealth is
22 not entitled..... 72,000

23 For the payment of approved claims for the
24 refunding of liquid fuels taxes and fuel use
25 taxes to which the Commonwealth is not entitled... 5,500,000

26 For the payment of approved claims for the
27 refunding of emergency liquid fuels tax moneys
28 to which the Commonwealth is not entitled..... 1,000

29 Refunding liquid fuels tax - political
30 subdivision use..... 1,000,000

1	For the payment of salaries, wages and all	
2	necessary expenses for the proper administration	
3	of the refunding of liquid fuels tax - political	
4	subdivision use.....	52,000
5	Refunding liquid fuels tax - volunteer fire	
6	companies, volunteer ambulance services and	
7	volunteer rescue squads.....	300,000
8	For the payment of salaries, wages and all	
9	necessary expenses for the proper administration	
10	of the refunding of liquid fuels tax - volunteer	
11	fire companies, volunteer ambulance services and	
12	volunteer rescue squads.....	29,000
13	Refunding liquid fuels tax - to Boating Fund	
14	for the use of the Fish Commission for the	
15	improvement of the waters of Pennsylvania on	
16	which motorboats are permitted to operate.....	1,500,000
17	For the payment of principal and interest	
18	requirements on general obligation bonds issued	
19	for transportation projects.....	163,262,000
20	For payment of principal and interest	
21	requirements on general obligation bonds issued	
22	for the General State Authority projects.....	180,000
23	For payment of the compensation of the	
24	Commonwealth's loan and transfer agent for	
25	services and expenses in connection with the	
26	registration, transfer and payment of interest	
27	on bonds of the Commonwealth and other services	
28	required to be performed by the loan and transfer	
29	agent.....	100,000
30	For the payment of interest on tax	

1	anticipation notes.....	3,300,000
2	For the payment of legal fees, advertising,	
3	cost of engraving and other expenses incurred	
4	in the issuance of tax anticipation notes.....	20,000
5	To the Department of Education	
6	For administration of the school safe driving	
7	program, and for payments to school districts or	
8	joint school organizations for driver education	
9	courses.....	4,408,000
10	To the Department of General Services	
11	For the payment of rental charges to the	
12	General State Authority.....	1,450,000
13	To the Department of Revenue	
14	For the proper administration and enforcement	
15	of the regulations under "The Liquid Fuels Tax	
16	Act," "Motor Carriers Road Tax Act," and "Bus	
17	Compact".....	3,466,000
18	To the Pennsylvania State Police	
19	For transfer to the General Fund to finance	
20	the traffic control and the traffic safety	
21	facilities program of the Pennsylvania State	
22	Police.....	93,641,000
23	For transfer to the General Fund to finance	
24	the Municipal Police Officers Education and

26	Section 3. In addition to the amounts appropriated by this	
27	act, all moneys received from the Federal Government or from any	
28	other source as contributions to or payments for the programs	
29	provided herein shall be paid into the Motor License Fund and	
30	are hereby appropriated out of the Motor License Fund for the	

1 purposes and programs intended.

2 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
