## A SUPPLEMENT

(P.L. , No. ), entitled "An act to provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and 2 3 Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt, 4 and for the public schools for the fiscal period July 1, 1977 to June 30, 1978, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending 6 7 June 30, 1977, "itemizing appropriations required from the 8 Motor License Fund for the proper operation of the several departments of the Commonwealth authorized to spend Motor 9 10 License Fund moneys. 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 12 13 Section 1. This supplement shall be known and may be cited 14 as the "Motor License Fund Supplement to the General Appropriation Act of 1977." 15 16 Section 2. The following sums or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the Motor 17 License Fund to the hereinafter named agencies of the 18 19 Commonwealth for the payment of salaries, wages and other 20 compensation and travel expenses of the duly elected or

appointed officers and employees of the Commonwealth, for

- 1 SECTION 4. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUPPLEMENTARY ACT THE
- 2 SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION, PRIOR TO ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT
- 3 WITH A PRIVATE AGENCY, COMPANY OR CORPORATION FOR CONSULTANT
- 4 SERVICES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO HIGHWAY PRE-DESIGN AND
- HIGHWAY DESIGN WORK, SHALL NOTIFY ALL DISTRICT ENGINEERS AND ALL 5
- MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE AND SENATE TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEES IN 6
- WRITING OF THE PROPOSED WORK TO BE DONE. THE DISTRICT ENGINEERS 7
- SHALL THEN SUBMIT IN WRITING TO THE SECRETARY AND ALL MEMBERS OF
- 9 THE HOUSE AND SENATE TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEES THE REASONS WHY
- 10 THEIR DISTRICT OFFICE CAN OR CANNOT PERFORM SUCH WORK. THIS
- 11 REPLY SHALL BE SENT WITHIN 30 DAYS OF RECEIPT OF THE SECRETARY'S
- 12 LETTER. THE SECRETARY SHALL DECIDE WHETHER A CONTRACT SHALL BE
- 13 AWARDED ON THE BASIS OF THE DISTRICT ENGINEER'S REPORT. NO
- 14 CONTRACT SHALL BE AWARDED IF THE REPORT OF THE DISTRICT ENGINEER
- 15 SHOWS THAT A DISTRICT OFFICE CAN PERFORM THE WORK, EXCEPT WHERE
- 16 THE SECRETARY SUBMITS A WRITTEN EXPLANATION TO THE CHAIRMAN OF
- 17 BOTH THE HOUSE AND SENATE TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEES STATING THE
- 18 REASONS WHY SUCH CONTRACT SHOULD BE AWARDED.
- 19 Section 4 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
