1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	To the act of December 22, 1977 (No.102), entitled "An act providing for the capital budget for the fiscal year 1977- 1978," itemizing public improvement projects, to be constructed by the Department of General Services, together with their estimated financial cost; authorizing the incurring of debt without the approval of the electors for the purpose of financing the projects to be constructed by the Department of General Services, stating the estimated useful life of the projects, and making an appropriation.			
10	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania			
11	hereby enacts as follows:			
12	Section 1. Itemization and authorization of projects.			
13	Additional capital projects in the category of public			
14	improvement projects to be constructed by the Department of			
15	General Services, its successors or assigns, and to be financed			
16	by the incurring of debt, are hereby itemized, together with the			
17	respective estimated financial cost and the total additional			
18	amount authorized for the public improvement projects, as			
19	follows:

9 Section 2. Debt authorization.

10 The Governor, Auditor General and State Treasurer are hereby 11 authorized and directed to borrow, from time to time, in 12 addition to any authorization heretofore or hereafter enacted, 13 on the credit of the Commonwealth, subject to the limitations provided in the current capital budget, money not exceeding in 14 15 the aggregate the sum of \$1,453,000 as may be found necessary to 16 carry out the construction of the public improvement projects specifically itemized herein. 17

18 Section 3. Issue of bonds.

19 The indebtedness herein authorized shall be incurred from 20 time to time and shall be evidenced by one or more series of 21 general obligation bonds of the Commonwealth in such aggregate 22 principal amount for each series as the Governor, Auditor 23 General and State Treasurer shall determine, but the latest 24 stated maturity date shall not exceed 30 years from the date of 25 the bond first issued for each such series.

26 Section 4. Estimated useful life of projects.

27 The General Assembly states the estimated useful life of the 28 public improvement projects heretofore itemized is not less than 29 30 years from the date of completion thereof, which period is 30 hereby stated to be the maximum term of the debt to be incurred. 19780S1304B1615 -2 - 1 Section 5. Appropriation.

2 The net proceeds of the sale of the obligations herein 3 authorized are hereby appropriated from the Capital Facilities 4 Fund to the Department of General Services in the maximum amount of \$1,453,000 to be used by it exclusively to defray the 5 financial cost of the public improvement projects specifically 6 itemized in a capital budget. After reserving or paying the 7 8 expenses of the sale of the obligation, the State Treasurer shall pay out to the Department of General Services the moneys 9 as required and certified by it to be legally due and payable. 10 Section 6. Allocation of funds. 11

Whenever as determined by the Department of General Services the full estimated financial cost of the public improvement projects itemized in section 1 hereof are not necessary for the proper design or construction of the projects, the excess funds no longer required may be allocated to increase the estimated cost of any one or more of the public improvement projects specifically itemized in a capital budget.

19 Section 7. Effective date.

20 This act shall take effect immediately.

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
