SENATOR SMITH, APPROPRIATIONS, AS AMENDED, MAY 31, 1978

A SUPPLEMENT

1 To the act of (P.L. , No.), entitled "An act to
2 provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and
3 Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt,
4 and for the public schools for the fiscal period July 1, 1978
5 to June 30, 1979, and for the payment of bills incurred and
6 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending
7 June 30, 1978," itemizing appropriations required from the
8 Motor License Fund for the proper operation of the several
9 departments of the Commonwealth authorized to spend Motor
10 License Fund moneys.

11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12 hereby enacts as follows:

13 Section 1. This supplement shall be known and may be cited
14 as the "Motor License Fund Supplement to the General
15 Appropriation Act of 1978."

16 Section 2. The following sums or as much thereof as may be
17 necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the Motor
18 License Fund to the hereinafter named agencies of the
19 Commonwealth for the payment of salaries, wages and other
20 compensation and travel expenses of the duly elected or
21 appointed officers and employees of the Commonwealth, for
22 contractual services and other expenses necessary for the proper

2	For payment from the restricted revenue	
3	account for aviation fuel taxes and airport	
4	operations revenue, for aviation operations	
5	including the operation and maintenance of	
6	State-owned aircraft, payment of general expenses,	
7	supplies, printing and equipment; for the

9	and the maintenance and repair of landing fields,	
10	intermediate landing fields, landing field	
11	equipment, beacon sites, other navigation	
12	facilities, and the encouragement and development	
13	of civil aeronautics.....	4,528,000
14	For rental payments to the State Highway and	
15	Bridge Authority for projects constructed with	
16	funds borrowed by the Authority.....	33,150,000
17	For payments to municipalities to assist in	
18	maintenance and construction costs of roads in	
19	accordance with the act of June 1, 1956	
20	(P.L.1944, No.655), relative to the allocation	
21	of highway funds.....	89,811,000
22	For payment from the restricted revenue	
23	account for aviation fuel taxes for airport	
24	construction and development including	
25	encouragement and development of aeronautics,	
26	development of State airports, assistance to	
27	political subdivisions and municipal authorities	
28	in the construction and improvement of airports	
29	and other aeronautical improvement of airports	
30	and other aeronautical facilities.....	3,000,000

1 No more shall be expended from this item for
2 such purpose or any of them than may be required
3 to match an equal sum contributed by any political
4 subdivision, or municipality authority of the
5 Commonwealth or by the Federal Government, or by
6 a political subdivision or municipality authority
7 and the Federal Government as provided in the act
8 of May 2, 1947 (P.L.136, No.56), entitled "An act
9 relating to Federal aid to political subdivision
10 or municipality authority for the development of
11 public airports."

12 To the Treasury Department

13 For the payment of replacement checks issued
14 in lieu of outstanding checks when presented and
15 to adjust errors..... 50,000

16 For payment of refunds of liquid fuels taxes
17 for agricultural use to which the Commonwealth
18 is not entitled..... 5,000,000

19 For the payment of salaries, wages and all
20 necessary expenses in the proper administration
21 of the program to refund liquid fuels taxes for
22 agricultural use to which the Commonwealth is
23 not entitled..... 76,000

24 For the payment of approved claims for the
25 refunding of liquid fuels taxes and fuel use
26 taxes to which the Commonwealth is not entitled... 5,500,000

27 For the payment of approved claims for the
28 refunding of emergency liquid fuels tax moneys
29 to which the Commonwealth is not entitled..... 1,000

2	For the payment of salaries, wages and all	
3	necessary expenses for the proper administration	
4	of the refunding of liquid fuels tax - political

9	For the payment of salaries, wages and all	
10	necessary expenses for the proper administration	
11	of the refunding of liquid fuels tax - volunteer	
12	fire companies, volunteer ambulance services and	
13	volunteer rescue squads.....	33,000
14	Refunding liquid fuels tax - to Boating Fund	
15	for the use of the Fish Commission for the	
16	improvement of the waters of Pennsylvania on	
17	which motorboats are permitted to operate.....	1,700,000
18	For the payment of principal and interest	
19	requirements on general obligation bonds issued	
20	for transportation projects.....	168,489,000
21	For payment of principal and interest	
22	requirements on general obligation bonds issued	
23	for the General State Authority projects.....	293,000
24	For payment of the compensation of the	
25	Commonwealth's loan and transfer agent for	
26	services and expenses in connection with the	
27	registration, transfer and payment of interest	
28	on bonds of the Commonwealth and other services	
29	required to be performed by the loan and transfer	
30	agent.....	100,000

1 To the Department of Education
 2 For administration of the school safe driving
 3 program, and for payments to school districts or
 4 joint school organizations for driver education
 5 courses..... 4,202,000
 6 To the Department of General Services
 7 For the payment of rental charges to the
 8 General State Authority..... 1,450,000
 9 To the Department of Revenue
 10 For the proper administration and enforcement
 11 of the regulations under "The Liquid Fuels Tax
 12 Act," "Motor Carriers Road Tax Act," and "Bus
 13 Compact"..... 3,436,000
 14 To the Pennsylvania State Police
 15 For transfer to the General Fund to finance
 16 the traffic control and the traffic safety
 17 facilities program of the Pennsylvania State
 18 Police..... 87,942,000
 19 For transfer to the General Fund to finance
 20 the Municipal Police Officers Education and
 21 Training Commission..... 1,300,000
 22 Section 3. In addition to the amounts appropriated by this
 23 act, all moneys received from the Federal Government or from any
 24 other source as contributions to or payments for the programs
 25 provided herein shall be paid into the Motor License Fund and
 26 are hereby appropriated out of the Motor License Fund for the
 27 purposes and programs intended.
 28 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 1978.
