10	No.14), known as the "Public School Code of 1949," amended
11	November 20, 1968 (P.L.1079, No.331), is amended to read:
12	Section 321. Compensation; Oath of Office All persons
13	elected or appointed as school directors shall serve [without
14	pay except as hereinafter provided] and be compensated in
15	accordance with the following schedule:
16	Directors of First Class A
17	School Districts\$4,500 per annum
18	<u>Directors of Second Class</u>
19	School Districts\$4,000 per annum
20	Directors of Third Class

1 School Districts......\$3,500 per annum 2 <u>Directors of Fourth Class</u> 3 School Districts......\$3,000 per annum Before entering upon the duties of their office each shall take 4 and subscribe to the following oath or affirmation, which may be 5 administered by any one qualified to administer an oath, or as 6 hereinafter provided:--7 8 I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support, obey and defend the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of this Commonwealth, and that I will discharge the 10 duties of my office with fidelity. 11 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall

apply to the fiscal year beginning on, or after July 1, 1979.
