## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, providing for six-year terms for Senators
- 3 and four-year terms for members of the House of
- 4 Representatives and changing the time of the election of
- 5 Senators.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby resolves as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 9 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with
- 10 the provisions of Article XI thereof:
- 11 That sections 2 and 3 of Article II be amended to read:
- 12 § 2. Election of members; vacancies.
- 13 [Members of the General Assembly shall be chosen at the
- 14 general election every second year.] Except for the elections
- 15 implementing this section and section 3 and except for elections
- 16 to fill vacancies in office, members of the House of
- 17 Representatives shall be chosen at general elections and
- 18 <u>Senators shall be chosen at municipal elections</u>. Their term of
- 19 service shall begin on the first day of December next after
- 20 their election. Whenever a vacancy shall occur in either House,

- 1 the presiding officer thereof shall issue a writ of election to
- 2 fill such vacancy for the remainder of the term.
- 3 § 3. Terms of members.
- 4 Except for the initial election implementing this amendment,
- 5 Senators shall be elected for the term of [four] six years and
- 6 Representatives for the term of [two] four years.
- 7 SCHEDULE
- 8 At the first general election after the effective date of
- 9 this amendment, Representatives in even-numbered districts shall
- 10 be elected for terms of four years and the Representatives in
- 11 odd-numbered districts shall be elected for terms of two years
- 12 and, 16 Senators shall be elected for terms of one year, 17
- 13 Senators shall be elected for terms of three years, and 17
- 14 Senators shall be elected for terms of five years. The method of
- 15 selection of the Senatorial districts which shall correspond to
- 16 the terms of one, three, and five years shall be provided for by
- 17 the General Assembly.
