## AN ACT

Providing for legislative review of proposed rules and 1 2 regulations. 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 4 Section 1. Short title. 5 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Rules and 7 Regulations Review Act." 8 Section 2. Definitions. 9 The following words or phrases when used in this act shall 10 have the meanings given to them in this section, unless the 11 context clearly indicates otherwise: 12 "Agency." Any department, departmental administrative board 13 or commission, independent board or commission, agency or any 14 other authority of this Commonwealth now existing or hereafter 15 created, but shall not include the Senate or House of Representatives or any court, the Pennsylvania Fish Commission, 16 the Pennsylvania Game Commission, political subdivision, 17 municipal or local authority. 18

1 "Rule or regulation." Any regulation, proposed or adopted by an agency prescribing or directing activity or forbearance. The 2 3 term shall not include a proclamation, executive order, 4 directive or other similar document promulgated by the Governor but shall include a rule or regulation which may be promulgated 5 by an agency only with the approval of the Governor. 6 Section 3. Rules and regulations automatically reviewed. 7 8 (a) Each agency shall transmit any proposed rule or regulation for approval to a joint committee composed of the 9 10 membership of the appropriate House and Senate Committees having 11 jurisdiction over the subject matter of the proposed rule or regulation. No rule or regulation may be finally adopted without 12 13 the approval of the appropriate joint committee.

14 (b) The joint committee shall set forth and transmit its 15 findings and decision to the head of the agency which proposed 16 the rule or regulation presented for approval.

(c) The House of Representatives and the Senate shall by concurrent resolution establish procedures for the referral of rules and regulations to joint committees and for the consideration of such rules and regulations by said committees. Section 4. Rejection of proposed rule or regulation.

(a) A proposed rule or regulation may be rejected or
accepted if a majority of the joint committee is recorded as
voting in favor of such action. Any rule or resolution not acted
upon within 90 days shall be deemed rejected.

26 Section 5. Effective date.

This act shall take effect in 60 days and shall apply to all rules and regulations proposed thereafter.
