21	(A) EACH APPLICANT FOR A LIMITED BROKER'S LICENSE SHALL AS A	
22	CONDITION TO OBTAINING A LICENSE TAKE THE LIMITED BROKER'S	

- 1 LICENSE EXAMINATION AND SCORE A PASSING GRADE. PRIOR TO TAKING
- 2 THE EXAMINATION:
- 3 (1) THE APPLICANT SHALL BE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OF AGE.
- 4 (2) THE APPLICANT SHALL HAVE BEEN ENGAGED FULL TIME AS A
- 5 SALESPERSON OR LIMITED SALESPERSON FOR AT LEAST THREE YEARS
- OR POSSESS EDUCATIONAL OR EXPERIENCE QUALIFICATIONS WHICH THE
- 7 COMMISSION DEEMS TO BE THE EQUIVALENT THEREOF.
- 8 (f) (B) The commission shall have the power to investigate <-
- 9 <u>licensees engaged in a business which applies to cemetery lots</u>,
- 10 plots and mausoleum spaces, openings or foundations and to
- 11 <u>suspend or revoke the license in accordance with the provisions</u>
- 12 of section 10 604 if it is determined that the licensee has

- 23 spaces, openings or foundations without first obtaining a
- 24 <u>license pursuant to this section unless such cemetery is owned</u>
- 25 <u>or controlled by a bonafide church or religious congregation or</u>
- 26 any association created by any such bonafide church or religious
- 27 congregation. Any person, copartnership, association or
- 28 corporation violating the provisions of this subsection shall be
- 29 <u>subject to the penalties provided in section 12. 303.</u>
- 30 <u>(b) It shall be the duty of the department, upon payment of</u> <

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- a license fee of twenty dollars (\$20), to issue a license to any 1
- 2 <u>person, copartnership, association or corporation desiring to</u>
- 3 <u>engage in or carry on a business within the Commonwealth within</u>
- 4 the limited field or branch of such a business which applies to
- 5 cemetery lots, plots and mausoleum spaces, openings or
- foundations. Such licenses, unless suspended or revoked, shall 6
- be renewed on a biennial basis for a fee of twenty dollars 7

- Section 3. 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days. 9

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
