## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 15, 1976 (P.L.1036, No.208), entitled 2 "An act authorizing the indebtedness, with the approval of the electors, of ten million dollars for loans to volunteer 3 4 fire companies, volunteer ambulance services and volunteer rescue squads for the purpose of establishing or modernizing facilities to house fire fighting apparatus equipment, ambulances, and rescue vehicles, and for purchasing new fire 7 fighting apparatus equipment, ambulances, and rescue 8 9 vehicles, protective and communications equipment, and any 10 other accessory equipment necessary for the proper performance of such organizations' duties, "extending 11 assistance in the form of loans for purchase of certain used 12 13 equipment AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN REFINANCING.

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- 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 15 hereby enacts as follows:
- 16 Section 1. Subsections (a) and (d) of section 4, act of July
- 17 15, 1976 (P.L.1036, No.208), known as the "Volunteer Fire
- 18 Company, Ambulance Service and Rescue Squad Assistance Act,"
- 19 amended September 22, 1978 (P.L.767, No.145), are amended to
- 20 read:
- 21 Section 4. Assistance to Volunteer Fire Companies, Ambulance

- 1 Service and Rescue Squads. -- (a) The department is hereby
- 2 authorized, upon application of any volunteer fire company,
- 3 volunteer ambulance service and volunteer rescue squad, to make
- 4 loans to said volunteer companies for the following purposes:
- 5 (1) Establishing or modernizing facilities that house fire
- 6 fighting equipment, ambulance or rescue vehicles. The amount of
- 7 a loan for establishing or modernizing facilities made to any
- 8 one volunteer fire company, ambulance service or rescue squad
- 9 shall not exceed 50% of the total cost of the facilities or
- 10 modernization or \$40,000, whichever is less, and a notarized
- 11 financial statement filed under subsection (c) shall show that
- 12 the applicant has available 20% of the total cost of the
- 13 facilities in unobligated funds. Proceeds of the loan shall be
- 14 used only for purposes of land acquisition or construction, and
- 15 shall not be used for payment of fees for design, planning,
- 16 preparation of applications, or any other cost not directly
- 17 attributable to land acquisition or construction.
- 18 (2) Purchasing fire fighting apparatus, ambulances or rescue
- 19 vehicles. The amount of a loan made for purchasing fire fighting
- 20 apparatus, ambulances, or rescue vehicles to any one volunteer
- 21 fire company shall not exceed \$35,000 for any single fire
- 22 fighting apparatus equipment, or 50% of the total cost of the
- 23 equipment, whichever is less. The amount of a loan made to any
- 24 one volunteer fire company, ambulance service or rescue squad
- 25 for any ambulance or rescue vehicle shall not exceed \$15,000 or
- 26 50% of the cost of the ambulance or rescue vehicle, whichever is
- 27 less, and a notarized financial statement filed under subsection
- 28 (c) shall show that the applicant has available 20% of the total
- 29 cost of the vehicle in unobligated funds.
- 30 (3) Purchasing protective, accessory or communication

- 1 equipment. No volunteer fire company, ambulance service or
- 2 rescue squad shall receive a loan for protective, accessory or
- 3 communicative equipment more than once in any five-year period.
- 4 Each volunteer fire company, ambulance service or rescue squad
- 5 may apply for a loan for mobile and portable radio unit for each
- 6 existing serviceable apparatus equipment, ambulance, or rescue
- 7 vehicle. Radio equipment obtained through loans under this act
- 8 shall be equipped with a frequency or frequencies licensed by
- 9 the Federal Communications Commission for fire fighting or
- 10 emergency response purpose. A notarized financial statement
- 11 shall be filed and loans under this act for the purchase of
- 12 protective, accessory or communicative equipment shall not
- 13 exceed \$5,000.
- 14 (4) Refinancing debt incurred or contracts entered into
- 15 [between] AFTER November 4, 1975 [and July 1, 1978 inclusive]
- 16 and used for the purchase of apparatus equipment or for the
- 17 construction or modernization of facilities or for modification
- 18 of apparatus equipment in order to comply with National Fire
- 19 Protection Association standards.
- 20 (5) Repair or rehabilitation of apparatus equipment. Where
- 21 it has been determined that existing apparatus equipment no
- 22 longer meets the standards of the National Fire Protection
- 23 Association (NFPA), and the repair and/or rehabilitation of such
- 24 equipment will bring it in compliance with NFPA standards; loans
- 25 for the repair or rehabilitation for a single apparatus
- 26 equipment shall not be for less than \$5,000 or more than \$35,000
- 27 or 80% of the total cost of repair or rehabilitation whichever
- 28 is less.
- 29 (6) Purchasing of used fire fighting apparatus, equipment,
- 30 <u>used ambulances, used rescue vehicles, used communications</u>

- 1 equipment, used accessory equipment or used protective
- 2 equipment: Provided, however, That the used vehicles and
- 3 equipment shall meet the National Fire Protection Association
- 4 (NFPA) standards.
- 5 Loans under this act may be made for any of the purposes of
- 6 this subsection undertaken by a volunteer fire company,
- 7 volunteer ambulance service and volunteer rescue squad on or
- 8 after November 4, 1975, the date of the approval of the
- 9 referendum approving the borrowing of money for the purposes of
- 10 this act.
- 11 \* \* \*
- 12 (d) Loans under this act shall be used for the acquisition
- 13 by volunteer companies of new or used apparatus equipment, new
- 14 <u>or used</u> ambulances, new <u>or used</u> rescue vehicles, new <u>or used</u>
- 15 communications equipment, new or used accessory equipment or new
- 16 or used protective equipment, or for the construction or
- 17 modernization of facilities and except as provided in subsection
- 18 (a)(4), shall not be used for operating expenses or for the
- 19 refinancing of construction or modernization of facilities,
- 20 apparatus equipment, communication equipment, accessory
- 21 equipment, nor except as provided in subsection (a)(4) shall
- 22 under this act be made or used to reduce any debt or other
- 23 obligations issued prior to the effective date of this act.

- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
