AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An

2 act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 5 laws relating thereto," authorizing certain persons to attend 6 the public schools after reaching twenty-one years of age. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 1301, act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the "Public School Code of 1949," is amended to 10 read: 11 12 Section 1301. Age Limits; Temporary Residence. -- Every child, 13 being a resident of any school district, between the ages of six 14 (6) and twenty-one (21) years, may attend the public schools in his district, subject to the provisions of this act. A person 15 16 who has been or is developmentally disabled may attend the 17 public schools in his district subject to the provisions of this act after reaching twenty-one (21) years of age and until he has 18 attended a total of thirteen (13) school years. The board of 19 20 school directors of any school district may admit to the schools

- 1 of the district, with or without the payment of tuition, any
- 2 non-resident child temporarily residing in the district, and may
- 3 require the attendance of such non-resident child in the same
- 4 manner and on the same conditions as it requires the attendance
- 5 of a resident child.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
