10	(a) Use of fundsThe commission is authorized to apply for
11	and subject to legislative appropriation use Federal funds
12	pursuant to the National Energy Act which is composed of:
13	(1) the "National Energy Conservation Policy Act,"

15	(2) the "Powerplant and Industrial Fuel Use Act of
16	<u> 1978," Public Law 95-620;</u>
17	(3) the "Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of
18	1978," Public Law 95-617;

1	(4) the "Natural Gas Policy Act of 1978," Public Law 95-
2	<u>621;</u>
3	(5) the "Energy Tax Act of 1978," Public Law 95-618;
4	(6) the "Energy Conservation and Production Act of
5	<u>1976, "Public Law 94-385; and</u>
6	(7) any future Federal legislation or amendments to the
7	above providing special funds for:
8	(i) rate-making research and development;
9	(ii) energy conservation research and development;
10	(iii) motor carrier and rail transportation safety
11	programs;
12	<u>(iv) gas safety programs.</u>
13	(b) Nonlapsing fundsAny funds the commission receives
14	pursuant to subsection (a) shall not be subject to lapsing at
15	the end of any fiscal period.
16	(c) Exemption from reimbursementNo funds under this
17	section shall be reimbursed to any utility.
18	Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
