3 AMENDING THE ACT OF JULY 4, 1979 (P.L.626, NO.9A), ENTITLED "AN <—
4 ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE EXECUTIVE, LEGISLATIVE
5 AND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH, THE PUBLIC DEBT
6 AND FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD JULY 1, 1979
7 TO JUNE 30, 1980, AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF BILLS INCURRED AND
8 REMAINING UNPAID AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL PERIOD ENDING
9 JUNE 30, 1979," ADDING CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS AND CHANGING
10 CERTAIN OTHER APPROPRIATIONS AND LANGUAGE.

11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12 hereby enacts as follows:

13 ~~Section 1. The sum of \$50,000, or as much thereof as may be~~ <—
14 ~~necessary, is specifically appropriated to the Afro American~~
15 ~~Museum in Philadelphia for the fiscal period July 1, 1979 to~~
16 ~~June 30, 1980 for the operation and maintenance of the museum.~~

17 ~~Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.~~

18 SECTION 1. SECTION 2, ACT OF JULY 4, 1979 (P.L.626, NO.9A), <—
19 KNOWN AS THE "GENERAL APPROPRIATION ACT OF 1979," IS AMENDED BY
20 CHANGING CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
21 WELFARE, ADDING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE

1 AND THE PENNSYLVANIA HISTORICAL AND MUSEUM COMMISSION AND BY
2 ADDING CERTAIN LANGUAGE RELATING TO AN APPROPRIATION TO THE
3 PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE TO READ:

4 SECTION 2. THE FOLLOWING SUMS, OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE
5 NECESSARY, ARE HEREBY SPECIFICALLY APPROPRIATED FROM THE GENERAL
6 FUND TO THE SEVERAL HEREINAFTER NAMED AGENCIES OF THE EXECUTIVE,
7 LEGISLATIVE AND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH FOR THE
8 PAYMENT OF SALARIES, WAGES OR OTHER COMPENSATION AND TRAVEL
9 EXPENSE OF THE DULY ELECTED OR APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES
10 OF THE COMMONWEALTH, FOR PAYMENT OF FEES OF CONTRACTUAL SERVICES
11 RENDERED, FOR THE PURCHASE OR RENTAL OF GOODS, SERVICES,
12 PRINTING, EQUIPMENT, LAND AND BUILDINGS AND FOR PAYMENT OF ANY
13 OTHER EXPENSES, AS PROVIDED BY LAW OR BY THIS ACT, NECESSARY FOR
14 THE PROPER CONDUCT OF THE DUTIES, FUNCTIONS AND ACTIVITIES AND
15 FOR THE PURPOSES HEREINAFTER SET FORTH FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD
16 BEGINNING JULY 1, 1979 AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF BILLS INCURRED AND
17 REMAINING UNPAID AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE
18 30, 1979.

2 SECTION 2. (A) THE SUM OF \$18,312,000 IS HEREBY TRANSFERRED
3 FROM THE MOTOR LICENSE FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND FOR
4 APPROPRIATION TO THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE FOR TRAFFIC
5 CONTROL AND THE TRAFFIC SAFETY FACILITIES PROGRAM.

6 (B) THE FUNDS HEREIN TRANSFERRED AND APPROPRIATED ARE IN
7 ADDITION TO FUNDS APPROPRIATED FOR THE SAME PURPOSE BY THE ACT
8 OF JULY 4, 1979 (P.L.714, NO.11A), KNOWN AS THE "MOTOR LICENSE
9 FUND SUPPLEMENT TO THE GENERAL APPROPRIATION ACT OF 1979."

10 SECTION 3. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.
